



Continuing Care Assistant (CCA)

Do you want to obtain your CCA Certification?

The Continuing Care Assistant (CCA) Program has various methods available to gain CCA Certification. Recognizing Prior Learning (RPL) Methods are available to eligible participants who have prior experience and/or training in the health sector. The CCA Administration has an RPL Navigator project offering the RPL Methods to participants around the province. Phase I, provides an education plan (learning path) based on a unique assessment of experience and education. Phase II is where the learning path (already assigned) is met through module education.

Fees are:

- Phase I: PLAR assessment -\$402.50 if required;
- Phase II: module education -\$402.50;
- CCA provincial exam -\$287.50.

This is the time to get your CCA Certification, as fees will increase April 1, 2012.
